“And God saw everything that he had made, and behold, it was very good.”



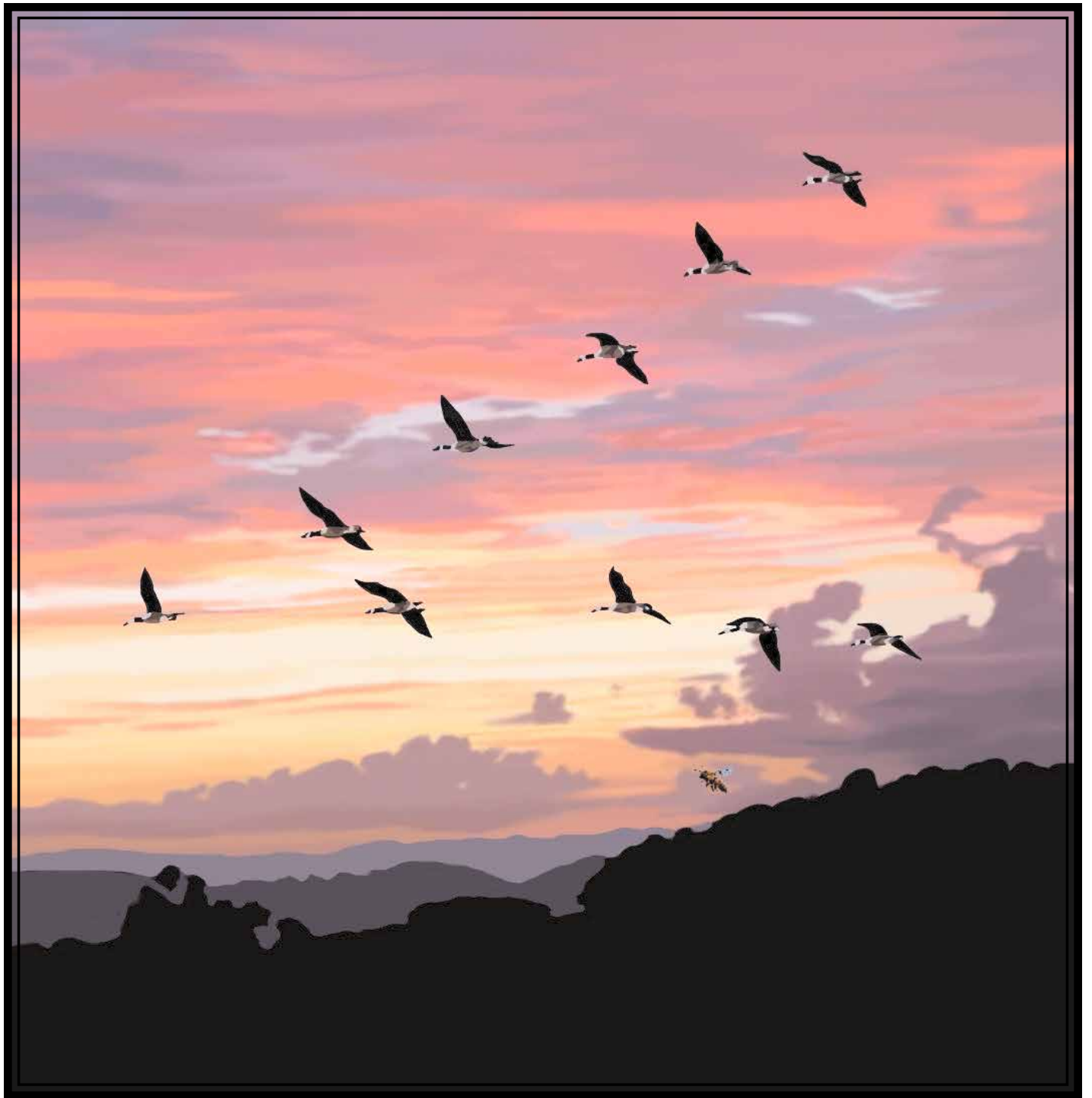


Birds
