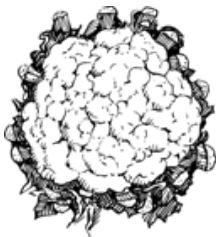

Read the following math story problems about orange items. Use the spaces in the boxes to work out the problem or draw a picture.

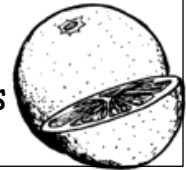
I ate 2 bowls of orange sherbet on Friday, 3 bowls on Saturday and 4 on Sunday. How many bowls did I eat all together?

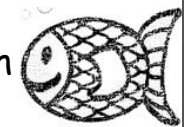
My PE class has 20 kids in it. If we get into groups of 5, how many basketballs will be needed so each group has one?

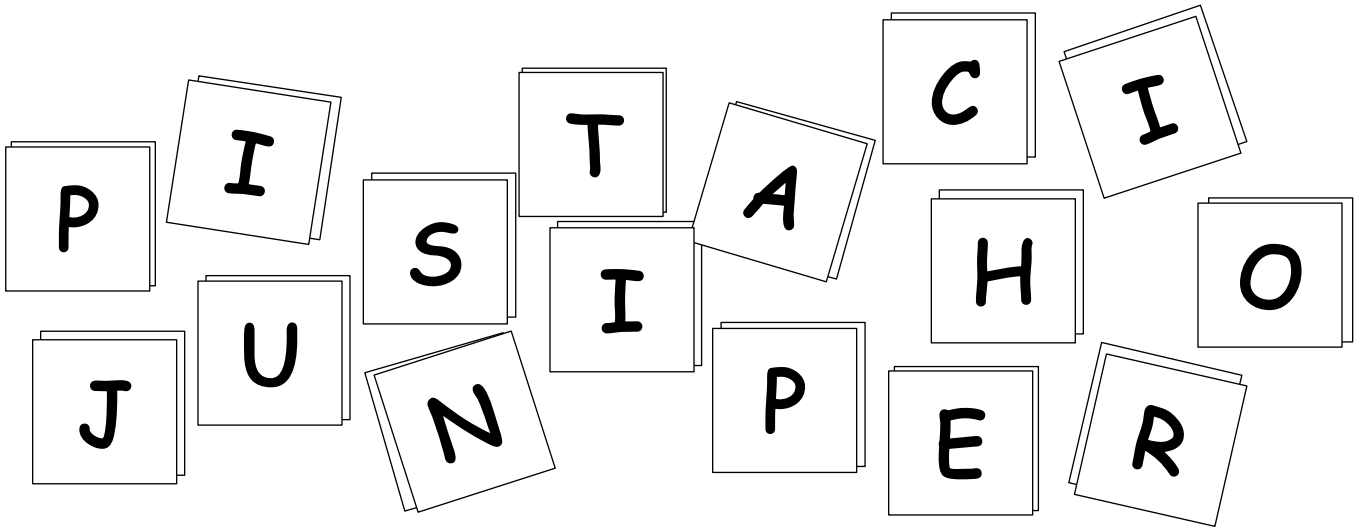

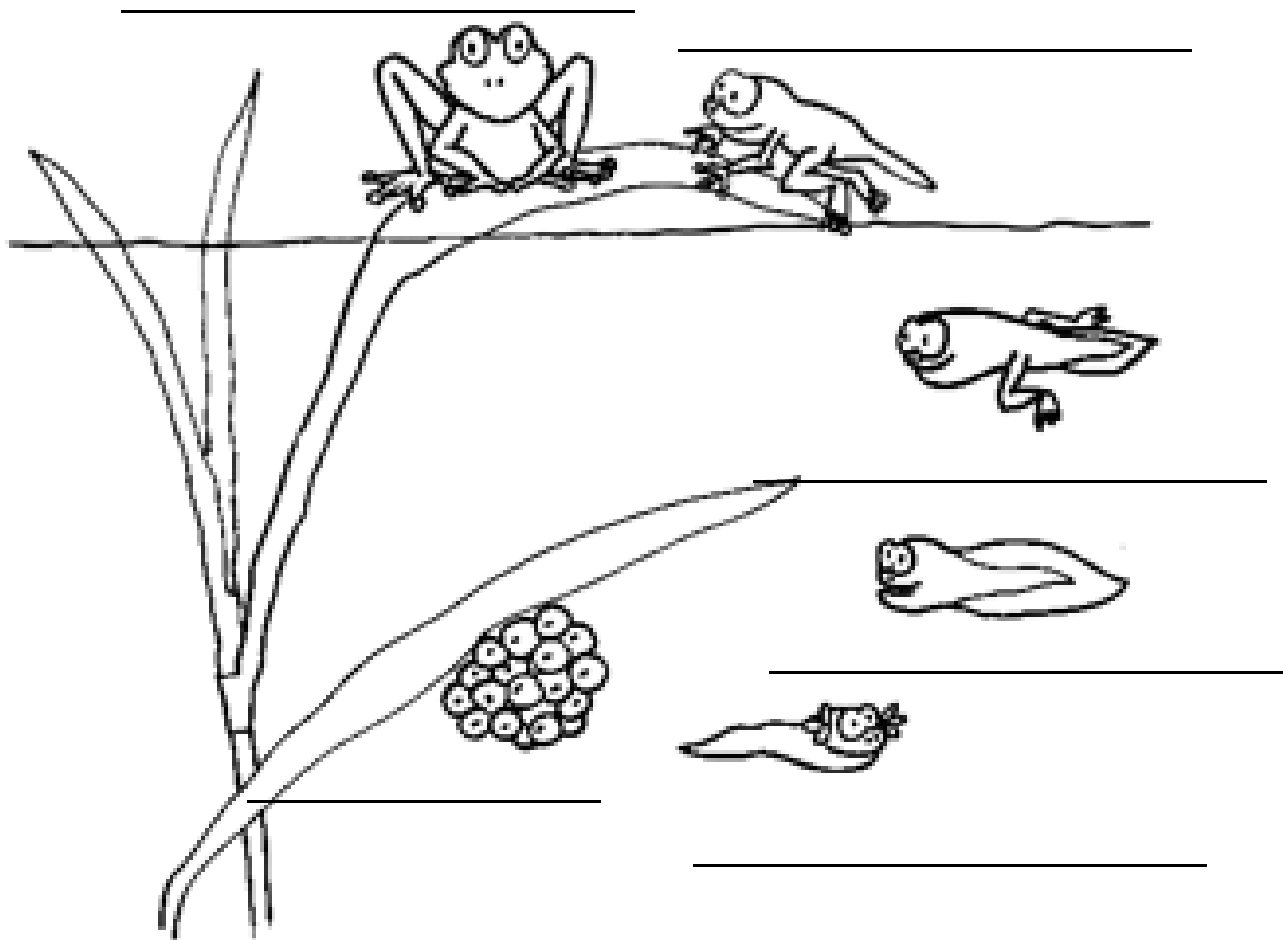
